This is a 100% benefit eligible, tenured/tenure-track faculty at the Professor/Associate Professor level in the Department of Oral Biology. The Chair provides leadership in meeting the School's educational, research, patient care and service missions. The Oral Biology Department has over 60 faculty, staff, and students and >\$6M in funding with focuses on biomaterials, mineralized tissue biology and clinical translational research. The department's graduate programs include Masters and Interdisciplinary Ph.D. studies in Oral Biology. Qualified candidates should hold a PhD or DDS/DMD, preference given to the candidate with the PhD and DDS/DMD. Preference will be given to a candidate with a strong background in clinical/translational research, a track record of funded research, and interdisciplinary leadership skills.
