# **Fellowships**

This year two members have been elevated to Fellowship status. These are Roland Frankenberger and Matthias Kern.

Roland Frankebberger graduated from the University of Erlangen Dental School and later joined the Department of Operative Dentistry and Periodontology at the University of Erlangen. For his thesis entitled 'Durability of resin-dentin bonds in vitro and in vivo,' he was awarded the German Miller Award, the highest scientific award in dentistry in Germany. He has published extensively and is well known for his work on dentin bonding, durability and the fatigue of dental restorations and interfaces.

Matthias Kern is a long-standing member of this Academy and has made significant contributions in adhesive cements, dental ceramics, and post & core fiber-reinforced restorations. He is currently Professor and Chairman of the Department of Prosthodontics, Propaedeutics and Dental Materials at the Christian-Albrechts University at Kiel, Germany. His publication list is extensive.

If you wish to be considered for Fellowship of this Academy then in the first instance you should consider the criteria for Fellowship as stated below:

Fellows shall be active Members who have attained a high level of achievement in the field of dental materials research. Those Members who are recognized to have advanced dental materials research shall be considered for Fellowship by the Fellowship and Awards Committee. Members awarded Fellowship status shall be inducted into Fellowship at the next annual meeting. Fellows maintain the same rights, privileges, and responsibilities of Members.

Specific **guidelines** for Fellowship status are:

- Achievement of advanced degrees: at least a master's degree and preferably a Ph.D., Odont Dr., or equivalent degree;
- Evidence of contribution: publication of at least ten (10), peer-reviewed, scientific articles in refereed journals. The candidate should be first author on one-half of the articles; and
- Longevity of commitment to the field: at least five (5) years of leadership through research, training, service and/or education beyond formal education.

If you are interested in becoming a Fellow of this Academy then please submit a *curriculum vitae* and letters of recommendation from a minimum of two Fellows of the Academy to:

Downloading of articles in PDF format from *Dental Materials* is now growing exponentially. The complete set of all issues of the journal are now available on *Science Direct*, and Academy members receive a password for access to *Science Direct* as part of their membership.

With the January 2007 issue of the journal you will notice the addition of a subtitle: "... Journal for Oral and Craniofacial Biomaterials Sciences." This specific wording was suggested by our immediate Past-President, Dorin Ruse, and was agreed after careful discussion at Editorial and Academy Board meetings. We retain all the existing emphases and coverage of scientific themes of Dental Materials, as explained in a previous editorial (January 2004). However, the subtitle is intended to highlight the

contemporary scope and depth of this research field, especially to our colleagues in different areas of dental science, who sometimes have a limited understanding of our field. Moreover, we aim to attract notice from online researchers using popular search terms such as *biomaterials* and *craniofacial*.

To activate access and to create your personal account, you will need your Elsevier Customer Reference Number. Your Customer Reference Number can be found on the mailing label of the paper issue of Dental Materials. The Customer Reference Number has to be entered at:
