The annual ADM meetings for 2003 and 2004 are in the planning stages. At this point, the sites have not been finalized. However, the Board is considering two excellent sites in the US for 2003. One site is in Virginia and the other is in West Virginia. The annual meeting in 2004 will likely be held in Geneva, Switzerland. The topics for these meetings have not been finalized, but preliminary discussions have begun. More information will be available soon.

Journal News from the Editor

The journal continues to attract a high manuscript submission-rate. David also noted that he has been increasing the number of reviews conducted electronically, and this is going very well. To assist with the volume of manuscripts, the Editor, Dr. David Watts, has appointed Dr. Ron Sakaguchi to serve as Associate Editor. Ron served in the past as the Associate Editor for Electronic Publishing.

The ADM Board have approved a forthcoming experiment by the Editor and Associate Editor. This is to allow electronic submission of manuscripts to the journal for a trial period of January - March 2002. This method of submission is optional during this period. Authors simply have to send an appropriate e-mail to the Editorial office at dentmatj@man.ac.uk with their MSS attached in Adobe Acrobat PDF format (only) as a single file including all figures. 'PDF' format is mandatory and any other file formats are NOT acceptable. The manuscripts will be logged in and sent on to reviewers. To prepare manuscripts in PDF format. from original versions in MS Word or WordPerfect etc, it will be necessary to use the Adobe Distiller program - which is a companion program to Adobe Acrobat Reader. We hope to provide guidance on these matters on the ADM web-site by January 1 2002.

The Academy is always working to bring new members into the organization. It is especially important to interest young researchers and newcomers to the field. Spread the word. The Academy of Dental Materials puts on an excellent annual meeting and distributes an outstanding journal.
