Message from the President

It is a pleasure and great honor to serve the Academy in the next two years, taking over from Jim Drummond, whom I would like to dearly thank for his leadership, great support and for leaving the Academy in excellent financial status. During his time as President two interesting and highly successful meetings were held (Siena, Italy 2001 and Honolulu, Hawaii 2002). This past meeting in Honolulu was the fourth international congress on dental materials jointly organized with the Japanese Society for Dental Materials (JSDM) which required a tremendous effort in coordination on both sides rewarded by the success of attendance. My special thanks go to the organizing scientific chairmen, Ron Sakaguchi (ADM) and Hiroshi Nakajima (ADM+JSDM) as well as both Presidents, Jim Drummond (ADM) and Minoru Nishiyama (JSDM) for their countless time devoted to the planning of the meeting. Last but not least and on behalf of the Academy, I would like to thank Dave Sarrett, our reliable and loyal transaction editor and his Secretary, Tammy Woolard, for collecting all the abstracts. manuscripts and editing a total of 370 pages in a record time!

As already announced in the previous newsletter, several board members have completed their terms leading to a renewal of nominees indicated in the list below. I would like to welcome the new board members, Jason Griggs (USA), Tom Hilton (USA), Marco Ferrari (Italy) and Richard Curtis (UK). Ann-Marie Neme (USA) is replacing Jack Ferracane as the new secretary. Khajotia (USA) is taking over the position of web master from Ron Sakaguchi. Mahendra Bapna who has served valuable years as Fellowship & Student award chair is replaced by Richard Curtis. George Cowperthwaite (USA) will take over the corporate liaison position from Alan Boghosian (USA). Many thanks are expressed to all officers that have served the Academy in the past years.

This year (2002) has been impregnated by the discovery of non-delivery of issues of the journal Dental Materials to all ADM members. An e-mail

inquiry has shown the seriousness of the problem. From the 40 % of responses we received, the nondelivery was spread worldwide. Elsevier has acknowledged the distribution problem due to a new distribution management system and has promised to replace all missing issues to all the members within the next few months. From a separate mailing you received a few weeks ago the board has informed you about the latest developments. We will continue to monitor the distribution issue. The contact person at Elsevier in case of non-delivery is Mrs. Nicola Garvey (<n.garvey@elsevier.com>). I also urge every member to monitor their journal delivery and inform us in case similar problems experienced in 2003.

The next ADM meeting in 2003 is going to be held in Charleston, South Carolina, at the Westin Francis Hotel, Oct. 28-30, on the topic of Interfaces: models and dynamics. The purpose of this 3-day meeting is to address the important issue of interfaces in tooth structures, ceramic composites, fiber-composites, as well as at the dentin-resin junction. Sally Marshall will cover the structure-property relations at the dentin-enamel junction (DEJ) which are critical to tooth function and evaluate the DEJ as a biomimetic model for ioining mechanical dissimilar biomaterials. Jack Mecholsky will outline the procedure to develop synthetic toughened biomimetic composites based on the principles of natural laminated composite structures. Kevin Knowles will provide an understanding of interfaces by means transmission electron microscopy in structural ceramic composites (particulate, fiber or lamellar) and their ability to deflect cracks. Walter McDonough will address the glass-fiber/resin interface with the microbond test and chemical analysis. Joe Antonucci will explain the chemistry of silane and interface in dental polymers and composites. Finally, Paulette Spencer will discuss the molecular dynamics at the dentin-adhesive interface and show a chemical map of the dentinhybrid-adhesive interface.
